Marinating in God's Word: Luke 24:1-12

We've worried that the Coronavirus would change Easter. Actually, it's the other way around. So we'll see as we go back to the most basic Good News.

For further reflection on your own or in a small group, consider these questions:

- When you first realized that our Coronavirus restrictions would change our usual Easter plans, how did you feel? What pieces of our usual celebration do you miss the most?
- Jesus had told his disciples repeatedly that he would rise. Why do you suppose that they hadn't "gotten it," and were slow to get it, even once he did rise? What did finally enable them to get it?
- And what about you what has enabled you to get it, to get what it means that Jesus has risen?
- How does this most basic good news change the way you approach death? How you approach life? How you deal with the Coronavirus?
